The University of Huddersfield now offers a new and innovative course structure consisting of individual modules that can build into a **Diploma in Professional Studies (Resource and Waste Management)** with a progression route to a degree.

The selection of modules covers managerial, business development and technical aspects of resource and waste management, so specific individual or corporate needs can be addressed.

A unique aspect of the Diploma is the inclusion of a Personalised Learning and Professional Development module. The learner creates a portfolio including evidence of in-house and external training courses, attendance at conferences, exhibitions, seminars and site visits. The module will be supported by regular webinars and podcasts on topical issues. The real benefit of this module is the flexibility to personalise it to a specific job role or development need.

Designed to recognise the needs of employers and individuals

Flexible The format of stand alone modules means you can just focus on one specific topic area or mix and match to gain a broader breadth of knowledge. The range of modules includes both technical and managerial topics. The intensive modular approach minimises staff time out of the office and is perfect for Continuing Professional Development (CPD) purposes.

In depth Each module provides the insight and key technical detail on the specific subject, not just a general introduction.

Practical The course content is delivered by trainers who are industry experts in the topic, using real-life case studies. Each taught block of interactive lectures, discussions and seminars is complemented by a follow up project in the workplace that enable learners to apply new knowledge, whilst providing tangible benefits to the employer. The practical approach makes a real difference to day-to-day performance.

Recognised qualification The individual modules and Diploma in Professional Studies are validated by the University of Huddersfield. We are working towards accreditation by the Chartered Institute of Waste Management (CIWM).

Building on experience We will recognise previous qualifications and experience and these can count towards the Diploma. For example, a CoTC Level 4 is equivalent to two modules.

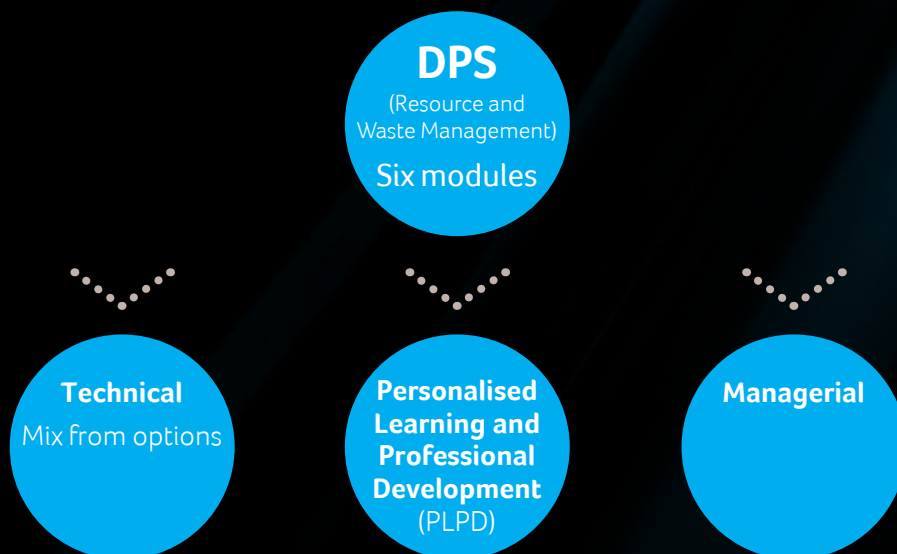

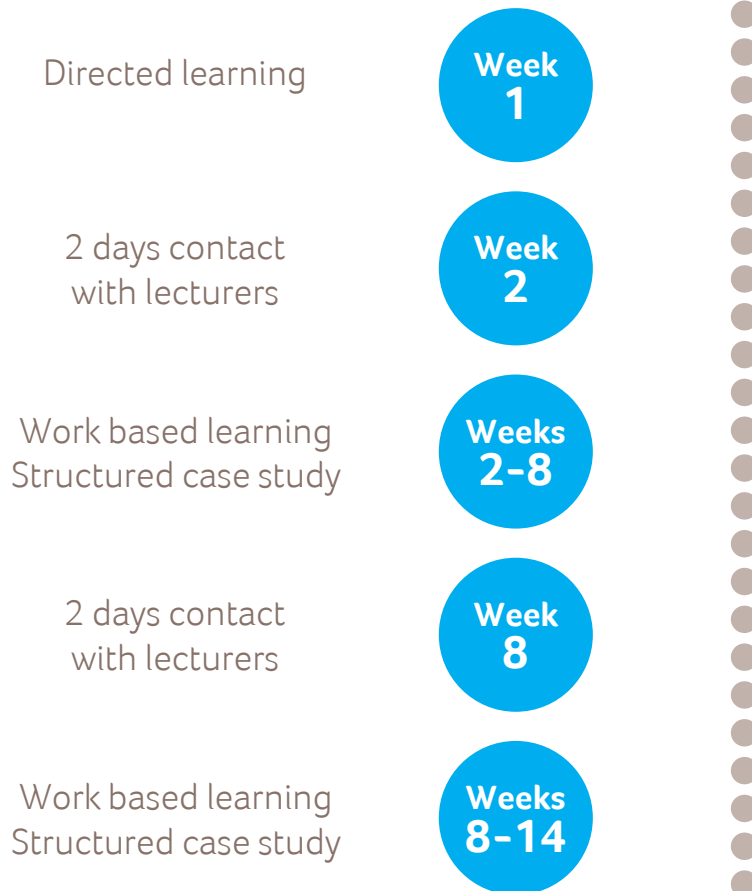
The management report submitted by students at the end of each module will provide the employer with a tangible deliverable business outcome.
