Child Protection Statement

The University of Huddersfield recognises that the safety and welfare of children is of paramount importance. The Schools & Colleges Liaison Service is committed to complying with the University's policy and to ensuring the safety and welfare of everybody who takes part in our activities.

The Schools & Colleges Liaison Service believes that it is important to meet its moral, legal and social obligations regarding the safety of young people.

To meet these obligations the Schools & Colleges Liaison Service shall:

- Ensure all staff and students involved in Schools & Colleges Liaison Service activity are made aware of, and follow, the University's child protection policy and procedures for reporting suspicions or allegations of abuse.
- Undertake appropriate measures to ensure that the safety of young people is paramount in the recruitment and selection of Student Ambassadors, Tutors and Mentors.
- Ensure that all members of staff and Student Ambassadors have access to appropriate training and can identify Designated Child Protection Officers.
- Disseminate the policy statement and procedures to other relevant parties.
- Assist the University as necessary in reviewing the procedures and ongoing monitoring and evaluation.

These procedures apply to everyone who has contact with children through Schools & Colleges Liaison Service activities.
